The first month's rent should be paid in advance. Those arriving in August pay the rent by the end of July. Students arriving in January pay the rent by the middle of December.

Students inside the European Union may use BIC (also called SWIFT) and IBAN for safe money transfers. Those arriving from outside Europe should transfer the amount to SGS check account.

Sometimes the foreign bank has another BIC code, **ESSESES**, which is to the bank in Stockholm. You can use this but the transfer may take a longer time.

Important. Please quote the **address** of your student accommodation and your **own** name on the payment so that it will be registered on the right customer.

Save your receipt or a draft of Internet payment and bring it with you on arrival.
