



How to setup DHCP on MAC OS X


In this guide it is assumed that you are using MAC OS X Leopard. It shows you how to configure MAC OS X to automatically get an IP-address through DHCP.



1. Click on the  icon in the upper left corner and choose **System Preferences...**



2. Click on the **Network** icon.



3. Highlight **Ethernet** and choose **Using DHCP** in **Configure IPv4**. Shortly after you should see the IP address that you have been assigned.

4. Click **Apply**.

Now you can use your Internet connection.
