
How to setup DHCP on Windows 7


In this guide it is assumed that you are using Windows 7. It shows you how to configure Windows 7 to automatically get an IP-address through DHCP.




- 1. Click on Windows logotype Control Panel
- 2. Click on Network and Internet
- 3. Click on Network and Sharing Center
- 4. Click on Change adapter settings



4. Right click on **Local Area Connection** and choose **Properties.**



5. Highlight **Internet Protocol Version 4** and click on **Properties**.



- 6. Choose Obtain IP address automatically and
- 7. Choose Obtain DNS server automatically
- 8. Click OK.

Now you can use your Internet connection.
